

Volunteer Driver Program

We are always seeking individuals interested in becoming a volunteer driver for our Elderly and Disabled Transportation Program.

Volunteer Drivers:

- Provide portal to portal transportation for elderly & disabled passengers to medical appointments and back home.
- Are given a user id and password for our web based dispatch program to volunteer for rides most convenient for them.
- Are provided all necessary training at no cost.
- Are reimbursed for the following expenses: mileage at the current IRS mileage reimbursement rate roundtrip from their home, meal expenses incurred during trips that are outside the driver's home county and parking fees.
- Are required to have proof of valid automobile insurance along with a valid driver's license on file at all times with the ADRC.

Elderly and Disabled Transportation Program

The Aging and Disability Resource Center of Northwest Wisconsin provides non-emergency transportation to and from local and out of area medical appointments to individuals 60 years of age and older and disabled individuals.

Cost

Co-payments are based on the number of miles traveled by the volunteer driver starting from and ending at the volunteer driver's home. We pick the volunteer closest to the passenger's home to ensure co-payments are as low as possible. Passengers are invoiced monthly based on the following rates:

Co-payment: \$0.29/mile

5 or more appointments per month: \$0.15/mile

Veterans: \$30/trip

Veterans who receive travel pay from the VA are required to pay that back to the ADRC Transportation Program.

Prices are subject to change from year to year.

Passengers are notified of all increases and decreases.

How do I get started?

Call the ADRC of Northwest Wisconsin at 715-485-8592 or 877-485-2372 at least 2 weeks in advance to ensure all paperwork is complete prior to when you'll need transportation assistance. You will be required to complete a demographic information form which gathers basic contact information as well as financial information helping us determine if you are able to pay the co-payment. Financial disclosure is an option, however, non disclosure will result in the full co-payment being charged according to the prices listed. Once you are entered and approved in the dispatch program you are eligible to make ride requests.

How do I schedule a ride?

Call the ADRC Transportation Reservation Line at 715-485-8592 or 877-485-2372 at least two business days prior to your appointment.

When you call please be prepared with the following appointment information;

- Date
- Time
- Facility Name and Address

This information is required in order to enter your ride request in the dispatch program.

Once a driver has been assigned to your ride request, you will receive a call from the driver 24-48 hours prior to the trip to make final travel arrangements.

Can I submit a ride request for other needs like grocery shopping?

Medical appointments take precedence over other appointments or needs. We try to accommodate as many people as possible and understand there is a great need for public transportation to other locations outside of medical appointments. If we are able to find a driver willing to accommodate your transportation request we will accept ride requests outside of medical appointments.
