Who We Serve

We proudly serve Polk and Burnett Counties.

We provide assistance to older adults and individuals living with a physical or intellectual/developmental disability, or with mental health/substance abuse issues (starting at 17.5 years old).

We offer guidance and assistance to caregivers and family members of loved ones, spouses, medical providers, and discharge planners, professionals in the community...anyone who cares about or is assisting an elderly or disabled individual.

We assist all people – regardless of income.

Who We Are

The Aging and Disability Resource Center, known as the ADRC, provides the general public with a warm and welcoming office to contact for information and assistance on issues affecting older people and people with disabilities, regardless of income.

The ADRC is the first place to go with your aging and disability questions. We are an “one stop shop” where you can receive accurate, unbiased information.

What We Do

By empowering people to find resources in their communities and make informed decisions about long-term care, ADRCs help people conserve their personal resources, maintain self-sufficiency, and delay or prevent the need for potentially expensive long-term care. ADRCs also serve as the single access point for publicly funded long-term care, including Family Care and IRIS.

It is never too early to start asking questions. We encourage you to call us and begin planning for your future needs. Of course, we can also assist you with questions or challenges you may be facing now.

Most services offered by the ADRC are provided free of charge. People who use the transportation services provided by the ADRC are charged a co-payment for rides. Meal services, such as congregate dining, do not charge a fee but a contribution to the program is appreciated if you are 60+ years of age. Others are asked to pay \$12 per meal. Home delivered meals have a waitlist for contribution based. If a new person wanted to skip the waitlist, they could pay \$12 per meal.

The Nutrition Program serves in-person meals at various locations throughout Polk and Burnett County. Meals are served around 11:30 AM. Reservations are required and must be made by 11:00 AM of the previous business day. For Monday meals, please call by 11:00 AM on Friday.

Meals provided contain 1/3 of the recommended daily intake for an adult. The menu is reviewed by a nutritionist and then prepared in our local kitchens. Meals are nutritionally balanced, and include an entree, sides, fruit dessert & milk.

Menus are available at dining sites, in our monthly newsletter (The Voice), and on the ADRC of NWWI Website. Menu is subject to change without notice.
