Find the county you live in to see which scheduled trips are available for you. The DRIVER that is scheduled for your trip will call you the day prior to let you know what time they will arrive to pick you up. The ADRC Transportation Department has THREE handicapped accessible vehicles that are used for any & all Social Events. The Minivan can hold 3 to 5 people & the Minibuses can hold 8 to 12 people. To reserve a seat call Cheryl the Transportation Coordinator at 715-485-8592 at least FIVE DAYS PRIOR TO THE TRIP.
